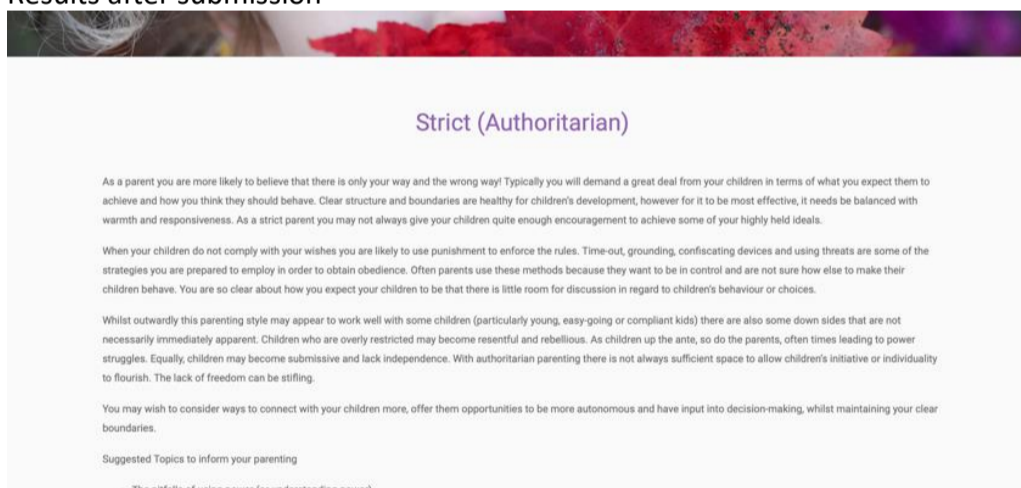

Research has shown that Assertive parenting is the most balanced and effective approach to use with normally developing children. As a parent using this style, you'll have high levels of warmth coupled with high expectations for your children. The combination of clear and reasonable limits together with compassion and encouragement provides the safety of structure with the freedom of choice. In other words, though you might expect your child to work hard at school, you will also support them to reach their goals and to do so in their own ways.

It is also likely that if you parent in this way you will value a high degree of communication and connection with your children. You are willing to discuss issues in depth, share your beliefs and listen to your child's point of view. Establishing this type of reciprocal and respectful relationship is the most effective springboard from which your children can thrive and flourish into independent and confident young adults.

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Lenient (Permissive or Indulgent)

As a parent you are warm and loving. Doting, in fact! You are nurturing to the point of supporting your children even when their decisions or behaviour are detrimental to others, including you and/or themselves.

By avoiding confrontation at all costs, giving in or allowing children to decide most things for themselves (from choosing their bedtime and what to eat, to choosing their friends and what to wear), you struggle to set clear and high expectations for your children and are likely to find it challenging to set limits for your children. When expectations for how to behave are unclear, children can be left feeling unguided and may develop a false sense of being in charge of the family.

Whilst children becoming independent and developing risk-taking might be upsides of this parenting style, a lack of boundaries can leave your child at a loose end. A child who is indulged without limits is more likely to develop a sense of entitlement, poor self-discipline and a lack of impulse control. When parented in this way, children often fail to learn important rules, which then negatively impacts their social experiences.

Some of the reasons parents may adopt this parenting style include compensating for their own childhood experience of overly strict parents, an inability to tolerate strong emotions from their children or simply because they do not know what else to do.

Fluctuating Parent (between Authoritarian and Permissive)

This parenting style is not one specifically mentioned in psychology and parenting, yet I believe that it is one of the most commonly used. It is even a little tricky to explain.

Whereas an Authoritative parent balances high demand together with high responsiveness, the Fluctuating parent moves frequently between Authoritarian (high demand/low responsive) and Lenient (low demand/high responsiveness) parenting. So although you set high expectations for your children and at times employ strict parenting methods such as time-outs, threats and punishments, you are equally prone to being permissive, giving in and being lenient.

Fluctuating parents often end up in a cycle where they hold high and reasonable expectations for their child and attempt to enforce these using punishment, reward and even offering children support to meet expectations. However, when the child either fails or struggles to meet their expectations (or simple refuses to), the parent's nurturing side kicks in. Parents might feel sorry for their child or judge that they've been too harsh and then in turn renege on the initial demand they placed on the child. When those expectations are not met the parent may not like the extra work and feel disappointed in themselves and in their children. When the resentment and anger mounts once again, the parents then attempt to reassert themselves using strict methods, which may seem over the top to the child. The cycle continues.

This cycle often arises because the parent holds high expectations for their child and knows that they do not want to be too strict or punitive, yet lack the appropriate strategies for to what to do instead. This creates an unpredictable and uncertain environment for the child because it is steeped in inconsistency. Parents who fluctuate between parenting styles in this way send mixed messages to their children and fail to hold their children accountable. They are usually also hard on themselves and end up feeling out of control of both themselves and their children.
